GENERAL

DISTRICT COMMISSIONERS SHOULD NOT SIGN ANY FORM PC WITHOUT REFERENCE TO THIS LIST.

This list of sites which are **not available**, or which are **not entirely suitable for the special conditions of Scout camping**, is circulated for the assistance of Scout Leaders in arranging camps and to avoid applications being made to owners who have already indicated that it is not convenient for them to allow camping on their land.

In areas listed as **Prohibited** permission to camp will not be given. In areas listed as **Restricted** permission to camp must be obtained in advance from the person named.

Secretaries and Commissioners in some areas receive many Camp Site enquiries each year. To avoid unnecessary correspondence, please do not write to more than one Secretary at a time in order to select a site, and do remember to enclose a SAE If you need an address of a County Secretary or Camping Secretary please refer to the back of this booklet for contacts.

The whole County except East Cleveland District.

Restricted

Cambourne, Redruth, Hayle District: within 3 miles of the coast.

Newquay and Truro Districts: within 2 miles of the coast. These areas extend along the North coast of Cornwall from Hayle to Watergate Bay.

NOTE: There are concentrations of public camping sites in parts of Cornwall. These are NOT suitable for Scout Camps, and only in most exceptional circumstances will approval be given for a smaller public camp to be used as a base camp. There are dangerous cliffs and many old mine shafts in the restricted areas, and elsewhere in the County, particularly in the West. Care must be taken in selecting all sites to avoid these. The Coastal Footpath needs walking with great care. Swimming on the North coast should only be on beaches patrolled by Lifeguards.

NO-ONE is permitted to undertake any old mines exploration or to enter any abandoned mine workings in Cornwall without the prior permission of the host District Commissioner and the County Mining Adviser who will have to be satisfied with the Leaders competence and knowledge of the particular mining system, also that those taking part will have appropriate clothing and equipment in good condition.

Only those camping sites shown on the list obtainable from the A.C.S. [Camping] may be booked in the Restricted Areas without the express permission of the D.C. Any other site in the Restricted Areas must only be booked after receiving the D.C.'s approval. Failure to comply could result in the need to abandon a camp.

SCILLY ISLES

Camping very restricted. There are a few Sites, but the Cornwall Secretary at the above address must be contacted before negotiations for camping are commenced.

CUMBRIA

Camping in the heart of the Lake District, particularly around Keswick and Ambleside, is subject to increasing controls and difficulties and whilst it offers great attractions by reason of its proximity to the popular lakes, is in danger of being over-camped not only by Scouts but also by the general public. Groups who decide to come to this area should therefore make the maximum use of the natural facilities - the fells and lakes - as camping space in this area is too valuable to be wasted. In other parts of the County, where in general camping is quite unrestricted, there are many excellent and secluded sites most of which are relatively unused. Details of such sites may be found in the Cumbria Information booklet published by the Cumbria County Scout Council at £3.50, including postage and packing, obtainable from the County Camping Secretary.

This booklet not only gives full details of Camp Sites available to the Movement within the County, but also ideas for use at camp and information on hill safety and water activity rules.

Groups are warned that a public camp site in the Lake District is rarely suitable for a standing Troop camp, and the use of this kind of facility should only be made in those areas where there is no readily available alternative camp site and the programme is one where the maximum amount of time will be spent out of camp using the lakes or fells.

Scout parties following the long walks through the County, i.e. The Pennine Way, Hadrian's Wall or the St. Bees to Robin Hood's Bay walk, should inform the C.Cp.S. of their intention, giving details of the route to be followed and approximate timetable.

Access to lakes for water activities can be difficult especially on Windermere.

Groups wishing to undertake water activities as part of their camp programme should ensure that they have checked on access and also obtained permission to use the lake in question where this is needed. Advice on this last point is contained in the Cumbria Water Activities Folder obtainable from the C.Cp.S. and this leaflet also gives details of The Cumbrian Water Activities Advisers who are all prepared to assist visiting Groups.

N.B. RIVER EXE AT BAMPTON

In order to protect fish stocks and breeding grounds, there is no access to the Rive Exe between Halfpenny Bridge and Chain Bridge [Map Ref: SS 945206 - O.S. Landranger Sheet 181] except by special permission from the owners of the water rights. DARTMOOR WARNING:

Large areas of Dartmoor are used by the armed forces for weapon training. A 1:50,000 scale map showing these areas is available from - Range Liaison Officer, Headquarters Devon and Cornwall Training Areas, MOD Mount Wise, Devonport, Plymouth, Devon PL1 4JH. Red flags are flown when training is in progress. Bye-laws make it an offence to enter Range Areas when firing is in progress. **IT IS ALSO SUICIDAL.**

THE NATIONAL PARKS - Dartmoor & Exmoor

All parties wishing to undertake Expeditions in these National Parks are invited to submit full size O.S. map route tracings [with map number] and other basic information, to the Advisers listed below. These details should be submitted at least four weeks before the expedition, to allow the Advisers to check access and route suitability.

Large groups [over 25], MUST comply with the above request, so that the National Park Authorities can be informed.

This is in addition to the normal submission of Forms PC for Standing Camps, and the Green forms required for ALL Dartmoor Duke of Edinburgh's Award expeditions [including practices]. Problems
